Building the smart motorway: how will it affect you?

Upgrading the M20 to a smart motorway involves installing a lot of technology and infrastructure as well as converting the hard shoulder to a permanent driving lane. Between July 2018 and March 2020 construction work will include taking down and replacing the deck of Teapot Lane footbridge, installing new gantries that display travel information, lane availability and variable speeds when necessary; new drainage, and emergency refuge areas.

If you live close to the motorway you are likely to hear and see the work we are doing and sometimes this work will need to take place at night, as well as during the day. We are running two events where we will use computer software and videos to show you what the new smart motorway will look like. Engineers responsible for the construction will explain how we will build it and what to expect if you live nearby.
